Place value: read and write numbers to 100 (numerals and words) recognize the value of each digit in a 2 digit number.

Properties of number and number sequences: counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10

Fractions: recognise $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{3}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$, write simple fractions of amounts and shapes.

Developing and Applying calculation: Recall addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently. Add and subtract numbers.

Multiplication and Division: Recall and use multiplication and division facts for 2, 3 5, and 10 times tables.

Science

Humans & Animals: What happens to our bodies as we grow? What do we need to be fit and healthy? Do animals grow the same way as humans? The importance of exercise. Why is it important to keep clean? E_Safety: Creating Media – Capture, edit and improve images through digital photography.

Geography

The United Kingdom: natural / manmade features, changes over time, comparing England to the Isle of Struay (Katie Morag link), the points of a compass using atlases, globes and digital media to find out geographical facts.

Art

Painting: study and create work in the style of Mondrian and Kandinsky. Develop painting skills, create colour wheels and explore primary and secondary colours.

Design Technology

Puppets: design a product for a purpose. Use running stitch to join fabrics. Colour and decorate textiles. Evaluate ideas and product against criteria.

History

The Gunpowder Plot: understanding events, describing Guy Fawkes. Using different sources to find out about the past. Order events on a timeline.
